Starting Rite is a baby-centred course run over five weeks.

We do lots of fun activities with babies under one:

singing, story-telling, bathing, baby massage and other multisensory play.

Starting Rite is open to anyone but may be of particular interest for those thinking of having their baby christened or holding a thanksgiving service for their child.

You may be asking yourself what church can offer you and your family.

You may be thinking about having your child christened, but would like to understand it a bit more.

You may be wondering about what values you would like your child to grow up with.

You may be interested in how to introduce your child to God.

Starting Rite helps you to think through and answer some of these questions, while having lots of play and bonding with your baby.
